**ORDER IMPOSING UNIFORM PRETRIAL PROCEDURES OF THE  
FAMILY DIVISION-FIFTEENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT**

1. In all cases in which either party has requested the implementation of the Uniform Pretrial Procedures, the Joint Pretrial Statement must be completely filled out by the attorneys (or pro se litigant if unrepresented) and filed with the Clerk of Court no later than ten calendar days prior to trial in this cause. A courtesy copy of the Joint Pretrial Statement shall be provided to the presiding judge. Failure to comply may result in sanctions against the offending attorney or unrepresented party. A copy of the form Joint Pretrial Statement is available in the Self Service Center as well as on-line at [www.palmbeachbar.org](http://www.palmbeachbar.org) under the Family Law Practice Committee's "Approved Forms" page.

2. Both the Petitioner and Respondent must designate their witnesses, including experts and their opinions forty-five (45) calendar days prior to the first day of trial of this case. Rebuttal witnesses shall be designated by both parties no later than thirty (30) days prior to the first day of trial of this case. It shall be the obligation of the attorneys and/or unrepresented party to make their experts timely available for deposition before the discovery deadline.

3. The Petitioner and Respondent shall exchange exhibit lists no later than ten (10) calendar days before the first day of trial of this case.

4. All discovery shall terminate ten (10) calendar days prior to the first day of trial of this case.
